Toilets

In the amusement park, all public toilet buildings have accessible toilets. Additionally, there is a changing room for adults accessible through the Music Hall.

Access regulations at the attractions

To enter the attractions via the special entrances, you need a purple or yellow wristband. These wristbands are obtained from the Guest Service after signing the "Visitor Declaration for Persons with Disabilities".

Yellow Wristband: This wristband indicates that you are able to enter and exit an attraction independently. You can also evacuate to another location independently. You can complete the entire attraction without assistance, adopt a specific seating position, tense up during a ride, and follow verbal or visual instructions. Through the entrance for persons with disabilities, you may bring a maximum of 3 people.

Purple Wristband: You cannot enter an attraction independently, but with the assistance of a companion (at least 18 years old), you can enter and exit. With this companion, you can board and disembark and adopt a specific seating position. You can complete the entire attraction with the help of your companion and follow verbal or visual instructions. In total, you may bring a maximum of 3 people through the entrance for persons with disabilities.
